

*The Awareness of Intuition and Its Role in Problem Solving*

Abstract

This study used a survey methodology to evaluate to what degree respondents to an intuitive/psychic abilities questionnaire use intuition in routine problem solving and decision making. The subjects experienced a greater sense of trust and reliance on feelings when evaluating their intuitive experience. Many subjects attribute intuitive information as emerging internally. Many of the subjects reported the theme of loss of a loved one marking their first intuitive experience; several subjects used metaphors to describe intuitive information processing.
