Abstract

This study investigates the psychotherapeutic value of practical ontology in establishing witness consciousness. A focus group and five interviews were conducted to explore four assumptions related to practical ontology training and witness consciousness. The findings demonstrated strong support for each assumption. Practical ontology assists subjects to shift consciousness by surrendering ego-centered positions.
