

*Acute Alteration of Biophoton Emissions by Intention, Vols I-III*

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Abstract

Through a variety of accepted scientific, experimental, statistical, and psychoanalytical techniques published in September 1999, this three volume work captures the first experimental evidence of human bioenergy effects at a distance. Applying the Motoyama Apparatus for Meridian Identification (AMI), subjects were enclosed in the copper Faraday room at the California Institute for Human Science where they underwent a variety of experiments exploring aspects of biophotonic emission, the results of which contributed seed research to the field of biophotonics. Bioenergy is traced through formulation, somatic accumulation, intentioned direction, and hand emission to effect photon bursts in crystal lattice structures.
